

Baguio AGE 15 € Julius Sebastian Joshua Laxamana AGE 17 **ON AUGUST** 14, 2018 Three friends hailing from Tarlac City **Tarlac** left for Baguio City to join a Dota 2 tournament, but only one of them was able to return home safely. Joshua Laxamana reportedly died in a shootout after allegedly fleeing from a checkpoint, while Julius Sebastian, 15 years old, is still missing.

## ON THE WAY HOME FROM A DOTA 2 TOURNAMENT,

17 year-old Joshua Laxamana died from a shoot-out with the police, his friend Julius has been missing since August 2018.

PNP Police Regional Office 1 reported that Laxamana tried to escape a dragnet operation via motorcycle after disregarding a prior checkpoint conducted by the PNP Personnel. The 17-year-old tried to fire shots with his Colt Cal .45 Pistol after losing control of his vehicle, but the police's retaliation caused him his death. The police reported that they were able to retrieve a heat-sealed sachet of illegal drugs on the dead body. After the investigation, the police also claimed that Laxamana was involved in four robbery cases in the province of Pangasinan where he was shot dead.



## Randy Malayao

Malayao's ride stopped at a bus stop in Aritao, Nueva Vizcaya. At 2:00 AM a gunman reportedly climbed aboard, approached the sleeping victim and shot him. He was killed on the spot. The gunman left right after the scene with a companion on a motorcycle.

Malayao was gunned to death inside a bus in Aritao, Nueva Vizcaya at 2:30 in the morning.

This was not the first attack against Randy.

On the night of May 15, 2008, Randy disappeared. Before his supposed "abduction," he reportedly texted a relative, "Someone is following."

Nearly 5 days after his disappearance, Randy resurfaced inside the 5th Infantry Division camp in Gamu, Isabela. The military claimed he was arrested after he alighted from a bus in Cainta, Rizal. "My captors covered my head with a plastic bag which caused me to suffocate. I was made to lie down on bare cement purportedly to simulate how it feels dying that way. On several occasions, they forced me to raise my two feet while sitting on a chair until my feet got stiff and my muscles tired and ached," Randy said.
